

# Show Patterns Book Coordinator

**Mission: To prepare a pattern book that can be used at our shows that provide challenging Class A rated show patterns.**

Review and understand the National rules and regulations governing pattern/course design annually.

Assemble a committee to select and/or design courses or patterns that comply with the rules and regulations of the Pinto Horse Association of America. Be sure that all required gaits are called for in the pattern/course for the class type as defined in the PtHA rulebook.

Confirm the bi-annual renewal has been made to patterns source, [horseshowpatterns.com](http://horseshowpatterns.com).

Coordinate printing of the show pattern book, including providing a quote for the cost of printing to the Board of Directors. A minimum of two separate quotes should be obtained. Recommend retail printing to Board and exhibitor pricing.

Provide show office with annual supply of pattern books to be sold at the regular shows. Obtain approval from the Board of Directors on the price of the book to the exhibitors.

Make available to the ring steward, show manager, judges and the exhibitors a complete show pattern book for all pattern/courses that may be required at the regular shows. Judges pattern books are to be labeled Judge A, Judge B, Judge C and Judge D, with a note to return them to the office at the end of the weekend.

Provide a list of obstacles needed at the shows to the show manager and course designers. The show manager will be responsible for obtaining a set-up/take down crew for courses and securing the needed obstacles will be available at the shows.

The Pattern book should include a showbill and the following categories listed in the book by showbill order, with page numbers:

- Showmanship
- English Equitation
- Hunter and Jumping-In-Hand
- Reinsmanship
- Obstacle Driving
- Trail
- Western Horsemanship
- Bareback Western Horsemanship
- Western Riding
