

Trail Course Designer

Mission: To design, setup and supervise all Trail and Trail-In-Hand classes at the regular shows.

To review annually and know the National rules and regulations governing to Trail and Trail-In-Hand course designs.

To design Trail and Trail-In-Hand course patterns which comply with the rules and regulations of the Pinto Horse Association of America, and that will fit all trail classes with minimal adjustments for each class.

To make available to the judges and the exhibitors a copy of the Trail and Trail-In-Hand courses.

To arrange for obstacles to be available at the shows.

To have trail course designer or representative supervise the trail course set up committee with setup, re-setting of obstacles during the classes, and dismantle the course after the completion of the Trail and Trail-In-Hand classes. And to be available for questions during the show weekend.

Participate yearly on the pattern book committee for selecting and preparing patterns for the current year's book.
