

Code of Ethics Advisors

2 person job responsibility

Mission: To carry out the rule of the MPtHA Code of Ethics creed and address and notify the national association of any disciplinary actions.

Two advisors will be appointed annually by the current President. These two advisors and the current MPtHA Board of Directors will serve as the Governing Board.

The main mission of the advisors is to follow the MPtHA Code of Ethics creed of providing service to the Pinto Horse industry, recognize the need to do so in a professional manner, and to deal with the public and our colleagues with the highest degree of integrity.

Upon discovery by a show official of inhumane treatment, show management shall immediately report the matter to the Association.

Disciplinary action in accordance with MPtHA practices for infractions of the MPtHA Code of Ethics:

1. First offense – letter of reprimand.
2. Second offense – two year suspension of membership privileges of MPtHA.
3. Third offense – five year suspension of membership privileges of MPtHA.
4. Fourth offense – permanent suspension from MPtHA.

If for any reason the PtHA suspends an MPtHA member, the MPtHA will adhere to the same disciplinary action as PtHA.

Competition and Exhibition Rules and Regulations shall be continually reviewed to ensure such welfare is upheld.
